International vocalist, Annie Kozuch, spent 20 years in Mexico City and has performed throughout the United States and Japan with symphonies, bands and trios. She has performed at Feinstein's, the Metropolitan Room, the Laurie Beechman and Stage 72 in Manhattan; numerous venues throughout the tri-state area, as well as at the Natchez Jazz Festival in Mississippi and soon various venues in LA.

Her first CD **Here With You**, (2010) peaked at No. 6 on the CMJ jazz charts and **Mostly Jobim** (2013), landed No.19 on the charts. Whether performing as a duo, trio, quartet or a sextet, Kozuch delights her audiences performing an array of standards from the American Songbook (think Frank Sinatra) adding Mexican love songs from Ms. Kozuch's adopted homeland ("It's Impossible") with recent interpretations from their latest CD with Brazil's 'king of bossa nova', Antonio Carlos Jobim ("Girl from Ipanema").
